Dear Scholarship Candidate,

On behalf of Plantation Acres Homeowners Association (PAHA), we look forward to receiving and evaluating your scholarship application. Please read these scholarship guidelines and reach out to the listed contact with any questions.

An eligible John George Scholarship candidate is any student who is attending any school, college, university, or trade school:

- Who is a dependent of a Plantation Acres resident who has paid their PAHA membership for the current year the scholarship is being issued.
- Alternately is an active member of the PAHA Community Service Squad, with a minimum of 50 hours of accrued service by the application deadline, regardless of where they, their parent(s) or legal guardian live.

Candidates are to complete the application and answer any questions on their own and must be the original authors of the essay. A completed application form, essay, recommendation and, all supporting material must be received via email by 11:59 PM on April 15th, 2024.

Only completed applications will be considered by the PAHA Scholarship Committee. The amount and number of scholarships issued is based on available Association funds. Funds for the scholarship come from membership dues of supporting members and donations. The winner or winners of the Scholarship will be announced at the monthly PAHA Member Meeting on May 21st, 2024. Candidates are asked to join us for this May meeting for the announcement.

Completed applications must be received by no later than 11:59 PM on April 15th, 2024.

Fully completed applications must be submitted to Scholarship@pahaf1.org; any questions should also be submitted to this email address.

Applications must be scanned and emailed. Essays should be typed using a word processor application (Microsoft Word preferred) and attached separately to the email with the attached application. If more space is needed for any section, please use a separate page(s) and attach to the completed application. Similarly, please attach to the application any supporting documents you feel may be important for review, such as latest report card/transcript, etc.
